FCCWA Code of Conduct for all members

Did you know that FCCWA has a code of conduct? A code of conduct is really important because it acts as a guide and reference for all members. It helps to clarify FCCWA's values and principles and is a visible statement to the rest of the world what we stand for. Anyone who deals with FCCWA can look at our Code of Conduct and they will get a sense of who we are and what is important to us. Our Code of Conduct incorporates the standard of ethics that our breeders abide by and provides a reference point for Governing Council when they are dealing with any situations that may arise.

1 Purpose of the Code of Conduct

- 1.1 To provide members of the Feline Control Council WA (Inc) with a framework for appropriate conduct. This includes behaviour towards other FCCWA members, judges, general community members and cats.
- 1.2 The core principles that underpin the organisation must be the welfare of all cats that fall within the scope of FCCWA and the protection of the integrity of FCCWA pedigrees
- 1.3 Incorporated in this Code of Conduct is a Code of Ethics for all members who wish to be recognised as Registered Breeders. All FCCWA Registered breeders must agree to uphold and respect this Code of Ethics in their actions and dealings within the Cat Fancy.

2 General Principles of Conduct

General principles to guide the behaviour of FCCWA members include that all members must:

- a) Act with reasonable care and diligence
- b) Act with honesty and integrity
- c) Act lawfully
- d) Avoid damage to the reputation of the FCCWA (Inc)
- e) Treat others with respect and fairness.
- f) Abide by any rules, regulations or guidelines as determined by FCCWA (Inc) including Breeding, Showing, membership of Governing Council or any other activity. Such regulations will be available on the FCCWA website.
- g) Comply with the WA Cat Act (2011) and any other relevant legislation.

IMPORTANT UPDATE!

In July 2014, a change to the Code of Conduct was proposed that clause 3.1 (i) be added which states that all members must::

Provide information and access as required by Governing Council to resolve issues and/or complaints.

This is yet to be ratified by Council, but the intent is to ensure that where an issue is raised by a member, that under the code of conduct they are obliged to ensure they do what they can to resolve the issue. This is in response to discussions with the Minister for Local Government who wants to see that IF our members get special treatment, that they will also do their best to solve issues that arise. It is not a licence for Governing Council to act beyond their authority, it is a responsibility for members to do their best to maintain the high standards we set for ourselves and continue to differentiate ourselves from Back Yard Breeders

Constitutional review

FCCWA has a Constitution that was created many years ago. It has served us well over the years, but in order to ensure continuous improvement it is important to review the constitution from time to time to check whether changes are necessary.

DOCEP has developed model rules which impacts our constitution. In addition, the introduction of a website, the use of emails as a communication tool and the increase in popularity of owner-cages (for example) means that some of our rules need adjusting.

In our fast moving electronic world, some of the deadlines that were set in the past are no longer necessary or practical.

Governing Council has completed the review and will be publicising proposed changes over the coming months. Any amendments to the constitution will be done at an AGM, so you will have the opportunity to vote on changes.




FCCWA FUNDRAISING EVENT

Feline Infectious Peritonitis (FIP)

Notes from the Judges Guild Seminar presented by Associate Professor Jacqueline Norris from the University of Sydney. 7 June 2014. These notes are some points of interest raised during the presentation.

- FIP (Feline Infectious Peritonitis) is a fatal inflammatory disease in cats.
- It is induced by the FIP Virus, which is a mutant form of Feline Coronavirus.
- It was first reported in 1963, but was possibly seen as early as the 1950s.
- It was not until the 1970s that it was determined to be a mutant form of the Feline Coronavirus.
- FECV (Feline Enteric Coronavirus) is contagious. Most cats will shed the virus and be okay.
- FIPV (Feline Infectious Peritonitis Virus) is not usually contagious. It is tissue bound. However, there are occasionally clusters of the virus.
- FECV mutates in an individual cat. The virus loses its preference for intestinal cells and gains a preference for macrophages and becomes tissue-bound in places such as the kidneys, eyes, brain or lungs.
- FIPV causes an inflammatory response that is uncontrolled and the cat's body loses its ability to control infection.
- FECV is everywhere in the cat community
- FECV is not confined to the Gastrointestinal tract
- FECV and FIPV are indistinguishable. The only way to differentiate is biological behaviour.
- Purebred cats are more likely to get FIPV than domestic cats
- Male cats are more likely to get FIPV than Female cats (3x more)
- Young cats are more likely to get FIPV than older cats (50% of all cases are under 2 years old)
- Certain breeds are over-represented, including British Shorthair, Abyssinian and Devon Rex
- There are two forms wet and dry
- Birman cats are more likely to get the dry version.
- Test of fluids from FIP cats show high protein and high globulin.
- FCoV Serology is not a useful diagnostic test for FIP as the antibodies will just tell you that the cat has been exposed to Coronavirus. Need clinical symptoms too.
- Analysis of faeces is not used to test for FIP as once the virus mutates to FIPV, it loses its ability to develop in the intestine so it is not present in the faeces.







TYROSINE

Did you know that black cats need tyrosine in their diet to keep their coats black? Tyrosine is an amino acid found in protein and while it is not essential for nutrition, it plays an important part in the synthesis of melanin in hair. Without sufficient Tyrosine, your black cat's coat may turn a reddish-brown colour. This was all discovered by a trio of researchers Jim Morris, Quinton Rogers and Shiguang Yu at University of California Davis back in 2001. So, if your black cat's coat is looking a bit reddish, it may be insufficient tyrosine in his diet. However, there are other reasons why a coat may change colour, so it is best to check with your vet to rule out any health issues.
