ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The CatsWA AGM will be held on Monday 11 January 2016.

Time: 7.00pm

Venue: CatsWA Office, Unit 3, 8 Royal Street, Kenwick

Notice of business for discussion must be lodged in writing with the Secretary or a duly appointed deputy not less than 21 days prior to the date of the annual general meeting and shall be placed on the agenda for the meeting. The last date for items to be added to the agenda is **21 December 2015**.

The council as it stood for 2015 was as follows:

- Maree Carle, Judy Kluczniak and Michelle Harris were members of Council on a casual basis with terms to the end of 2015 (effective the AGM).
- Carole Galli's term finishes at the end of 2015.
- Linda Horton's term finishes at the end of 2016.
- Sue Game, Lucy Nikiforos and Janis Thompson all have terms finishing at the end of 2017.

Nominations were received from Maree Carle, Judy Kluczniak, Michelle Harris, Carole Galli and Martyna Furst.

This would normally have required an election. However, Linda Horton has relinquished her elected position which means that there are the same number of nominees as vacancies and therefore no election is required in accordance with clause 23.4 of the constitution. Linda will continue to participate in her various roles as determined by Governing Council.

Rule 23.11 of the Constitution also states that all Councillors will be elected to a 3 year term unless more than half of the Council positions are being filled in which case allocations to terms will be allocated as agreed by Governing Council. Where practical, Council will consist of an even spread of members with 3 years, 2 years and 1 year left on their terms.

As there will be 5 newly elected members allocation of terms will be decided at the first Governing Council meeting to be held in January.

Congratulations to the incoming Councillors and thank you for making this commitment to CatsWA. A special welcome to Martyna Furst who is taking up a position on Council for the first time.

Thank you to all the 2015 Governing Council members for their hard work in what has been a very busy year.

Social conflicts in cats

An interesting article appeared in Psychology Today in February 2015, titled “Resolving Social Conflict between familiar cats”

The article, written by Theresa L. DePorter, DVM, MRCVS, DECAWBM, DACVB, examines some of the ways that social tension may be an issue in a multi-cat household and suggests solutions that may help you manage the situation.

Steps for peaceful resolution of feline social tension:

- **Space.** Provide enough real estate for each cat to enjoy his/her preferred resting, playing, and eating activities while still avoiding stressful encounters with housemate cats.
- **Distribute important resources.** Each cat should have easy access to food, resting areas, scratching posts, toys, and litter boxes without encountering an unfriendly cat.
- **Don't force cats to interact.** Each time the cats experience an aggressive encounter, they are learning to fight next time. Patience is essential.
- **Never punish or startle cats that are displaying aggression or fear.** No yelling, squirting, or scaring. Cats may stop fighting and flee, but the overall tension will not be reduced.
- **Guide cats to move away from an aggressive or tense encounter.** Encourage either cat to move away by using a sweet, gentle tone of voice. You may coax your cat using food, treats, or toys. You may make noises that you know cause your cats to happily investigate (i.e., go to the kitchen and open a can of tuna).
- **Pavlovian or classical conditioning.** You can change the cat's emotional association by pairing the presence of each cat with the occurrence of a desirable reward.
- **Anxiolytic.** It may be necessary to reduce anxiety and distress with medications, pheromones, or natural supplements. Discuss options with your veterinarian.
- **Health.** Be sure your cats are healthy and see their veterinarian regularly. Underlying pain or discomfort such as osteoarthritis or dental disease can contribute to irritability and social tension.
- **Be realistic.** Some cats are not going to get along. Some cats will become friends. Some cats will achieve “aloof disregard” for each other.

The article is well worth reading in full and may provide useful if you have cats that don't get on particularly well.

All good fun and good PR for CatsWA. I believe we provided lots sunshine and happy faces at the Perth Pet Expo 2015 'cats corner'.

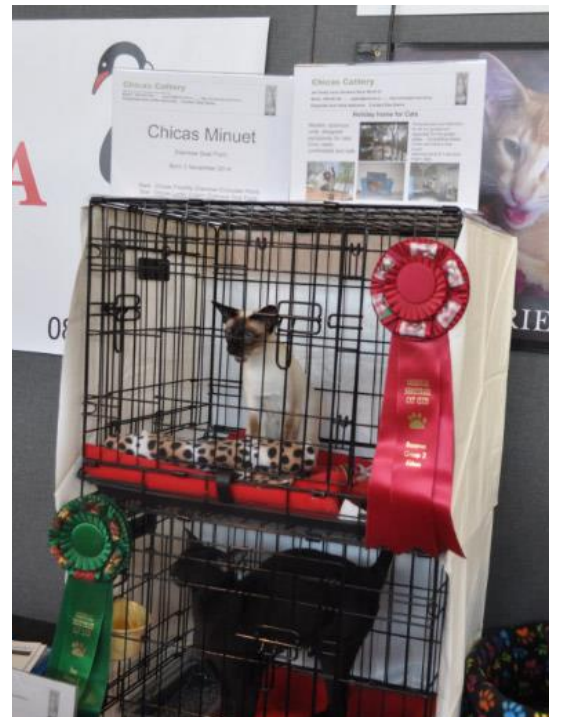

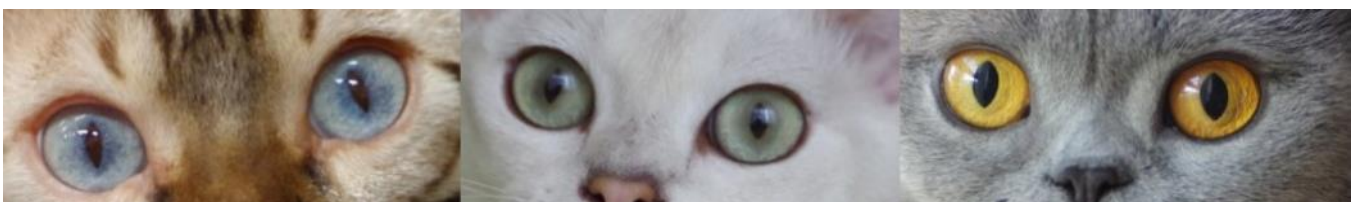

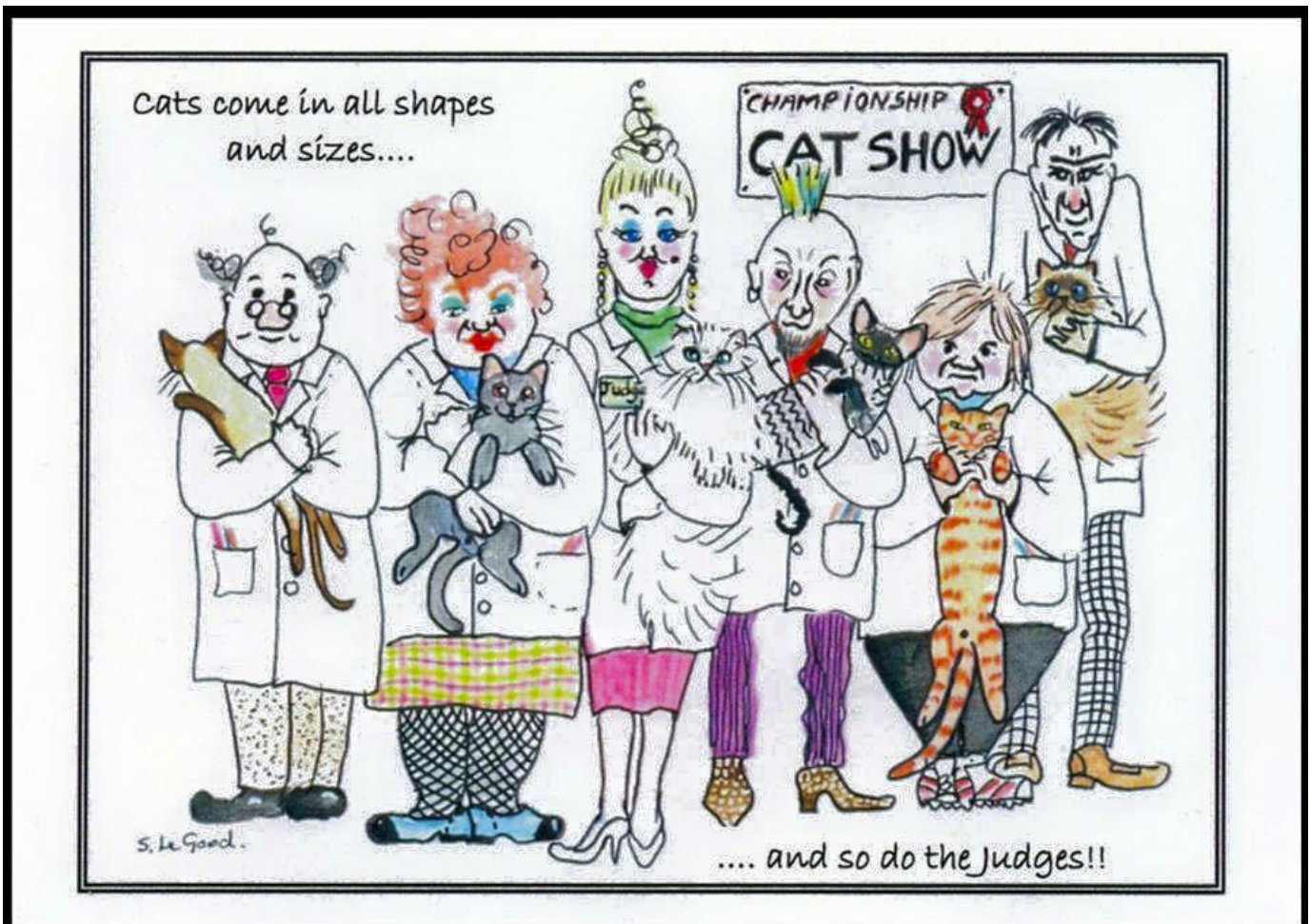

Code of Conduct for all members

Did you know that CatsWA has a code of conduct? A code of conduct is really important because it acts as a guide and reference for all members. It helps to clarify CatsWA's values and principles and is a visible statement to the rest of the world what we stand for. Anyone who deals with CatsWA can look at our Code of Conduct and they will get a sense of who we are and what is important to us. Our Code of Conduct incorporates the standard of ethics that our breeders abide by and provides a reference point for Governing Council when they are dealing with any situations that may arise.

1 Purpose of the Code of Conduct

- 1.1 To provide members of the Feline Control Council WA (Inc) with a framework for appropriate conduct. This includes behaviour towards other FCCWA members, judges, general community members and cats.
- 1.2 The core principles that underpin the organisation must be the welfare of all cats that fall within the scope of FCCWA and the protection of the integrity of FCCWA pedigrees
- 1.3 Incorporated in this Code of Conduct is a Code of Ethics for all members who wish to be recognised as Registered Breeders. All FCCWA Registered breeders must agree to uphold and respect this Code of Ethics in their actions and dealings within the Cat Fancy.

2 General Principles of Conduct

General principles to guide the behaviour of FCCWA members include that all members must:

- a) Act with reasonable care and diligence
- b) Act with honesty and integrity
- c) Act lawfully
- d) Avoid damage to the reputation of the FCCWA (Inc)
- e) Treat others with respect and fairness.
- f) Abide by any rules, regulations or guidelines as determined by FCCWA (Inc) including Breeding, Showing, membership of Governing Council or any other activity. Such regulations will be available on the FCCWA website.
- g) Comply with the WA Cat Act (2011) and any other relevant legislation.
